Types of grants

MINI GRANTS

Up to **\$2,500**
Available monthly

Designed for flexibility, Mini Grants feature a simplified application process. Matching funds not required. First-time applicants encouraged to apply!

MAJOR GRANTS

Up to **\$10,000**
Available three times a year

Major Grants represent the majority of AHA grant proposals and support a broad range of projects statewide. Cost-share match (1:1) required.

MEDIA GRANTS

Up to **\$15,000**
Available annually

Media Grants provide support for documentary films, audio series, web projects, and other digital media. Cost-share match (2:1) required.

2024 Alabama Public Humanities Grants APPLICATION CALENDAR

MINI GRANT DEADLINES (up to \$2,500)

First of each month: Mini Grants monthly application deadline

MAJOR GRANT DEADLINES (up to \$10,000)

March 15: Major Grants spring application final deadline

July 15: Major Grants summer application final deadline

November 15: Major Grants fall application final deadline

MEDIA GRANT DEADLINE (up to \$15,000)

June 15: Media Grants annual application deadline

BEFORE YOU APPLY:

AHA encourages all applicants — and particularly first-time applicants — to contact AHA's grants director to discuss project ideas and verify eligibility before beginning the application process: alabamahumanities.org/grants

Grant applicants are also strongly encouraged to submit a preliminary application to AHA for feedback on your proposal and eligibility. This is designed to support you in the application process, and strengthen final proposals.

- In your preliminary application, include a draft narrative and a draft budget.
- Due at least one month before the final application deadlines above.
- Available for all grant applications — Mini, Major, and Media.
